## ACT No. XXVI of 1872.

Passed by the Governor General of India in Council. (Received the assent of the Governor General on the 12th October 1872).

An Act to amend the Law relating to Opium in the Panjáb.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relat- Preamble. ing to op um in the Panjáb; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called "The Panjab Opium Short title. Law Amendment Act, 1872":

It extends only to the territories under the govern- Local extent. ment of the Lieutenant-Governor of the Panjáb:

And it shall come into force on the first day of Commence-January 1873.

2. In this Act and in the Panjáb Laws' Act, 1872, 'Opium' 'opium' includes also poppy-heads and all intoxicating defined. drugs prepared from the poppy.

Confiscation of opium.

5. Whenever any rule made by the Local Government under the Panjáb Laws' Act, 1872, and relating to the growth, sale or possession of opium, is broken, the opium in respect of which the breach is committed shall be liable to confiscation.
