An Act to amend the law relating to certain Courts and Offices in the Panjáb.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relat- Preamble. ing to certain Courts and Offices in the Panjáb; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called "The Panjáb Judicial Short title. Administration Act, 1875:"

the Deputy Commissioner of the District may from time to time, subject to any rules prescribed in this behalf by the Local Government, by general or special order direct.

Persons exercising such powers to be deemed to be Tahsíldárs or Deputy Commissioners.

5. Any person exercising any of the said powers shall, for the purposes of the law relating to appeals and for all other purposes connected with the exercise of such powers, be deemed to be a Tahsíldár or Deputy Commissioner, as the case may be.
