PASSED BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL OF INDIA IN COUNCIL.

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 8th February 1876).

An Act to authorise Revenue Agents to practise in suits in the Munsifs' Courts of the Lower Provinces of Bengal.

WHEREAS, by Act No. XX of 1865, Revenue Preamble. Agents are now prohibited from practising in Civil Courts; and it is expedient to authorise them to practise in Munsifs' Courts in suits under Bengal Act No. VIII of 1869 (to amend the procedure in suits between Landlords and Tenants); It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Revenue said Act No. XX of 1865, all persons duly admitted Agents may and enrolled as Revenue Agents under the same Act, and act in in the territories subject to the Lieutenant-Governor Munsifs' of Bengal, may appear, plead and act in Munsifs' Courts in suits under Bengal Act No. VIII of 1869 Bengal Act No. VIII of 1869 VIII of (to amend the procedure in suits between Landlords and Tenants), or under any other Act for the time being in force regulating the procedure in such suits.
