An Act to repeal certain words in the Sea Customs Act, 1878.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal certain words in the Sea Customs Act, 1878; It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Sea Customs Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1904.

2. The words "or being a colourable imitation Repeal of of", in clause (e) of section 18 of the Sea Customs part of section 18 (e), Act, 1878, as amended by section 10 of the Indian Act VIII, VIII of 1878. Merchandise Marks Act, 1889, are hereby repealed. IV of 1889.
