An Act to terminate doubts which have arisen as to the continuance in force of notifications, orders and rules made or issued under the Enemy Trading Ordinance, 1916.

THEREAS doubts have arisen as to the continuance in force of notifications, orders and rules made or issued under the Enemy Trading Ordinance, 1916, after the repeal of the said Ordinance by the Enemy Trading Act, 1916, and it is expedient to terminate such doubts; It is hereby enacted as follows:—
