ACT No. XIX of 1918.

PASSED BY THE INDIAN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 20th September, 1918.)

An Act further to amend the Indian Defence Force Act. 1917.

HEREAS it is expedient further to amend the III of 1917. Indian Defence Force Act, 1917; It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Indian Defence short title, Force (Further Amendment) Act, 1918.
- 2. After section 11 of the Indian Defence Force Insertion of Act, 1917, the following section shall be inserted, new section act III of 1917. namely: III of 1917.

"11-A. Any European British subject who for Enrolment of the time being has attained the age of 50 years may European offer himself for enrolment for general military subjects above service or local military service, and may be enrolled the age of 50 years. accordingly in the prescribed manner, and any person so enrolled shall be liable to all the obligations imposed on persons deemed to be enrolled for general military service or local military service within the meaning of this Act, as the case may be, and shall continue to be so liable until relieved thereof in the prescribed manner."
