## ACT No. XIX of 1919.

[PASSED BY THE INDIAN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.]

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 17th September, 1919.)

An Act further to amend the Indian Tariff Act, 1894.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Tariff Act, 1894; It is hereby enacted vill of 1894. as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Indian Tariff (Amendment) Act, 1919.

Amendment of section 10, 1894.

2. In clause (a) of section 10 of the Indian Tariff Act, 1894, (hereinafter referred to as the said VIII of 1694. Act) after the words "as the case may be," the words "or any part thereof," shall be inserted; and for the words "equivalent to the duty" the words "equivalent to the amount paid in respect of such duty" shall be substituted.

Amendment of Schedule of 1894.

3. In Schedule III of the said Act, items 3 and of schedule 111, Act VIII 4 shall be re-numbered 4 and 5, respectively, and after item 2, the following item shall be inserted, namely:
