## ACT No. II of 1919.

[Passed by the Indian Legislative Council.]

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 12th March, 1919.)

An Act further to amend the Indian Paper Currency (Amendment) Act, 1917.

WHERBAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Paper Currency (Amendment) Act, 1917; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Indian Paper short title. Currency (Amendment) Act, 1919.
- 2. In section 2 of the Indian Paper Currency Amendment xIX of 1917. (Amendment) Act, 1917, for the words "six hundred of section 2, and sixty millions," the words "eight hundred mil-1917. lions" shall be substituted.
- 3. The Indian Paper Currency (Amendment) Repeal of Act vi of 1918. Act, 1918, and the Indian Paper Currency (Amendanian Paper Currency (Amendment) Repeal of Act vi of 1918, and the Indian Paper Currency (Amendment) Repeal of Act vi of 1918.
