- 1. This Act may be called the Indian Telegraph (Amend-short title. ment) Act, 1930.
- 2. In clause (a) of the second proviso to sub-section (1) of Amendment of section 4 of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885, after the word Act XIII of "waters" the words "and on aircraft within or above British India, or Indian territorial waters," shall be inserted.
