WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Ports Act, 1908, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Indian Ports (Amendment) Short title. Act, 1931.
- 2. In sub-section (1A) of section 6 of the Indian Ports Amendment Act, 1908, for the words "at piers, jetties, landing-places, Act XV of wharves, quays, docks, warehouses and sheds" the words "in any port subject to this Act" shall be substituted.
