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THE MINERAL OILS (ADDITIONAL DUTIES OF EXCISE AND CUSTOMS) AMENDMENT ACT, 1964

No. 41 of 1964

[18th December, 1964.]

An Act further to amend the Mineral Oils (Additional Duties of Excise and Customs) Act, 1958.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Mineral Oils (Additional Duties of Short Excise and Customs) Amendment Act, 1964.
- 2. In the Mineral Oils (Additional Duties of Excise and Customs) Amendator of 1958. Act, 1958 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in the long title, for the words "certain mineral oils", the words "certain mineral title, products" shall be substituted.
 - 3. In section 1 of the principal Act, in sub-section (1), for the Amendwords "Mineral Oils", the words "Mineral Products" shall be ment of substituted.
 - 4. In section 3 of the principal Act, in sub-section (1), for the Table, the following Table shall be substituted, namely:—
