An Act to repeal the Banking Companies (Legal Practitioners' Clients' Accounts) Act, 1949.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Banking Companies (Legal Practitioners' Clients' Short title. Accounts) Repeal Act, 2001.

2. The Banking Companies (Legal Practitioners' Clients' Accounts) Act, 1949 is hereby repealed.
